	<b>Speech Value/Effectiveness (10 pts)</b> Ideas, logic, original thought, current, relevant	
	<b>Accurate Information (10 pts)</b> Up-to-date, complete	
	<b>Judges' Questions (10 pts)</b> Correct answers, keeps composure, exhibits depth of knowledge	
	<b>II. Presentation (50 points)</b>	
	<b>Voice/Communication (15 pts)</b> Audible, clear, body language, gestures	
	<b>Manner (10 pts)</b> Confidence, enthusiasm, handles unexpected happenings well	
	<b>Correctness (10 pts)</b> Grammar, pronunciation, word selection	
	<b>Visuals/Supplies &amp; Equipment (10 pts)</b> Attractive, readable, integrated well	
	<b>Physical (5 pts)</b> Inclusive of all abilities, neat, appropriate appearance
