The 4-H "MASTER'S" category is open to any previous state 4-H Presentation Gold Medal Winner in the 14-18 year old category. Each year the category's mandated presentation topic will be the current years "State 4-H Project." Master's participants are welcome to approach the topic from their individual creative stance. This category is being introduced to provide new opportunities for exemplary 4-H presenters. Youth who place Gold in their district DAD program may be called upon to present to community organizations, teach 4-H public speaking workshops, serve as coaches and peer judges for younger presenters.

	Physical (0 pts) Inclusive of all abilities, neat, appropriate appearance
